Invitation of online application for the posts of Vice Chancellor, Jharkhand University of Technology, Ranchi

The Search Committee constituted in accordance with the Jharkhand University of Technology Act ,2011 for recommending a panel of names for the post of Vice Chancellor, Jharkhand University of Technology, Ranchi invites online application from interested eligible candidates having scholarly pursuit, academic interest, administrative ability and other desired qualifications.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS-

1. As per UGC Regulations ,

“A person possessing the highest level of competence, integrity, morals and institutional commitment is to be appointed as Vice Chancellor. The person to be appointed as a Vice Chancellor should be a distinguished academician, with a minimum of ten years' of experience as Professor in a University or ten years' of experience in a reputed research and/or academic administrative organization with proof of having demonstrated academic leadership.”

2. The candidate/person should be a Ph.D. with first class or equivalent at the preceding degree, preferably in a branch of Engineering. In exceptional cases candidates with Science, Mathematics or Management degrees may be considered. He/She should have an outstanding academic record throughout and a minimum of 10 years teaching experience as a Professor in a reputed Engineering or Technology Institute or University and should have guided Ph.D. students or a minimum of ten years' of experience as a Professor or in an equivalent position in a reputed research and/or academic administrative organization with proof of having demonstrated academic leadership.
3. The pay scale and service conditions under UGC Regulation for the Vice Chancellors in the State of Jharkhand has been adopted by HRD Dept's Resolution No.5/Vi.1-06/2009/1188 dated 20.11.2010. Further, the pay scale has been revised in accordance with the recommendations of the 7th Central Pay Commission.
3. The candidates for the post of Vice Chancellor shall not exceed 65 years of age as on the date of publication of advertisement.
4. The application shall only be submitted online through the link available on website having URL www.jharkhanduniversities.nic.in
5. The application submitted through other modes shall not be taken into consideration by the Search Committee.
6. Recent self attested passport size photograph and signature of applicant shall be uploaded at the proper place.
7. All educational qualifications must have been obtained from recognized Universities/Institution in India and/or abroad and if grades are awarded

instead of marks, applicants should clearly indicate their numerical equivalent.

8. Please note that you can apply for the post of Vice Chancellor once only. After submission, you cannot open a new form and resubmit.
10. Suppression of any material information or misrepresentation in the application form shall automatically disqualify the candidate and further may attract prosecution.
11. Canvassing in any form will invite disqualification.
12. The applicants should have a valid e-mail ID to be kept active during the entire period of consideration. The Search Committee shall not be liable for failure of communication, if incorrect or inactive e-mail id is furnished.
13. The application should be submitted on or before 23rd November, 2020 by 6 PM . Late and/or incomplete applications shall not be considered.
